Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held in Bledlow Village Hall on Thursday, 1st September 2011

1. Apologies for Absence

Cllr. Stone and County Cllr. Rogerson

The Chairman welcomed Mrs Taylor to the meeting, following her co-option to the Council as ward member for Saunderton.

2. Minutes of the Last Meeting

The minutes of the meeting held on Thursday, 4th August 2011 were approved with all in favour after a proposal by Cllr. Ingram, seconded by Cllr. Mrs. Wylie.

3. Matters Arising

Road Maintenance

The Clerk had written a letter to Jim Stevens asking for the scheduled Bledlow Ridge roadworks to be brought forward to this year, and to request consideration of a system of allocating the repair budget on the basis of most needed rather than by allocating five roads to each County Councillor. No substantive reply had yet been received.

The Clerk is to meet Rob Sumner on Friday, and would ask for the Chapel Lane 30mph sign to be cleaned, for the hedge at The Crest to be cut to 7 feet high, and ask for confirmation that the Haw Lane hedge would also be cut in October. Rob would also be asked to confirm that action is to be taken about the flooding problem, also in Haw Lane.

On a related matter, Cllr. Ingram said that Mrs. Smith has plans to plant bulbs along the roadside in Bledlow Ridge. The Clerk said that he knwe of the proposal, and that a Cultivation Licence was needed. The meeting agreed that the Clerk should contact Mrs. Smith to say that planting should not go ahead until a planting plan was received.

Website

Cllr. Mrs. Wylie presented details of a website for Morton Parish Council that had been designed by Mr. Henson. Then site is a 'community' facility, and contains much more information, such as Parish Council minutes, accounts etc. than does the existing Bledlow-cum-Saunderton site on Bucksinfo. The meeting discussed the matter further, with value for money and hit rate being debated. Following a proposal by Cllr. Cox, seconded by the Chairman, it was agreed that Cllrs. Mrs. Wylie and Mrs. Stallwood should further research the matter and report back to the next meeting.

In the meantime the Ckerk would investigate ways in which the Bucksinfo site could be made more attractive by inserting photos and graphics, for example.

Bledlow Children's Home

Confirmation had been received from Bucks CC of the purchase price of the site, and this was accompanied by copies of an extract from the Land Registry documents showing the new owners of the site.

Neighbourhood Development Plans

It was agreed that further discussion of this matter should be deferred until the Government's Localisation plans are better defined and understood.

Electoral Review of Buckinghamshire

Cllr. Breese had reviewed the Boundary Commission's proposals and had concluded that they were broadly neutral so far as Bledlow-cum-Saunderton is concerned, and that no further action is needed.

BALC

The Clerk asked for it to be noted that the services provided by BALC are being widely questioned by a number of parish clerks. He was uncertain how the matter would be taken further, but would make enquiries as to whether raising the issue at WDALC would be the logical next step.

North West Chilterns Area Forum

The Chairman said that he would be unable to attend the next meeting of the Forum, and Cllr. Breese agreed to go in his absence. The Chairman also said that, after an unconvincing start, it would seem that the Forum is growing in effectiveness.

8. Other Business not Requiring Notice

It was noted that, after a site visit by Maria Whyte, WDC is minded to issue an Enforcement Notice.

Carrington Place
